WHAT ARE THE BIGGEST CHALLENGES YOU FACE AS A BUSINESS?

The redevelopment of historic buildings is always challenging, but transforming the historic Missouri Theater Building into the Angad Arts Hotel was the most complicated project I've ever experienced from a financing standpoint. Because this independent boutique hotel is located in St. Louis' Grand Center Arts District, where there aren't comparable developments, it was difficult to secure the necessary financing.
